Tentative Field Trip Locations:

Art Camp: Beginning camp with a visit from Dots and Doodles to create our own canvas painting then finishing the day swimming at the Woodlands. Later that week, Campers will visit the Art Museum in Pittsburgh finishing the day exploring the Natural History Museum. The following week, a trip to Conley's will complement our water art and that week we'll travel to North Park to hike, fish and enjoy natural art! Week three will be two days at Willow Brooks Stables learning about horses, horse care, sketching horses and riding horses! Finally, our last week of art camp we'll head back to North Park for more outdoor fishing and hiking fun then finish the week with a trip to the Toonseum in Pittsburgh.

Get Moving: Our first shortened sports camp week begins with a bowling trip to Mystic lanes and ends with a day outdoors! Week two will feature NZone Sports in cooperation with our camp counselors to offer a unique opportunity for playing, practicing and experiencing games as a camp crew! Week three of Get Moving will get us moving again at Willowbrooks Stables with the horses! Our final July week will have us swimming for hours at Conley's Indoor Water Pool and Slide, followed by a visit to the roller skating rink and a trip to the park.

STEM: Our STEM camp trips kick off with a trip to Fire & Ice, to experience velocity and force up close and personal! Later that week our campers will travel north to Jennings Nature Reserve followed by a visit to Moraine State Park. Week two offers the campers a special trip to North Park with a goal to explode and explore! A trip to Living Treasure Animal Park finishes the week with a focus on Biology and adaptive animals! Finally, our camp trips end with two trips to The Woodlands Retreat Center to golf, swim, zip-line and finish out camp with a BANG!
